The white sand beach at Gwangalli is about 400m long, and includes attractions like beach bars, beach beds, wind banners, and SUP photo zones.

### Busan Healing Forest

Busan Healing Forest is a healing forest occupying a total area of 153ha in Cheolma-myeon, Gijang-gun, the first of its kind in southwestern Korea. It takes about 40minutes for visitors to walk the entirety of the main trail. Other facilities on site include the forest library, mind sharing site, forest healing garden, forest meditation site, pine tree wind bathing site, and prenatal education forest site along the central trail.

### Eulsukdo Eco Park

Eulsukdo Eco Park consists of Eulsukdo Eco Park and the Eulsukdo Migratory Bird Park. Eulsukdo Eco Park is the centerpiece of the Sanctuary of Migratory Birds at Nakdonggang River Estuary (Natural Monument No. 179 of Korea), a haven for migratory birds in winter and the center of ecotourism in the Nakdonggang River estuary. Some of the facilities on site include the Nakdong Estuary Eco Center, Wildlife Medical Center, and the Nakdong Estuary Experience Center.

### Songdo Yonggung Suspension Bridge

Songdo's suspension bridge, a site of nostalgia for many residents, was restored after 18 years of inactivity and was opened to the public. This suspension bridge connects Dongseom Island, a small island, with the mainland, and is shaped after a "key of luck" that is said to bridge the lovers and attract good fortune. At night, the bridge lights up in gold. Try to make a wish when the Yonggung Suspension Bridge turns to gold.

### Songdo Sea Cable Car

Dudo Observatory, located 1.45km away from Songdo Yonggung Suspension Bridge, is the starting point of Songdo Sea Cable Car service. Rising up to 86m high above sea level, the Cable Car offers an unparalleled view over the blue water of Songdo Beach, Amnam Park, the South Port of Busan, and the Yeongdo area beyond.

### Oryukdo Skywalk

Opened in 2012, Oryukdo Skywalk is located at the end of a coastal cliff rising 35m above sea level. Its call to fame is the view of the emerald seas at Oryukdo Islets, where the East Sea meets the South Sea. The transparent glass floor offers a thrilling view of the waves crashing into the coastal cliffs below, while the sea beyond shines with blindingly pure blue.

### Jeoryeong Coastal Trail

Jeoryeong Coastal Trail is a 3km-long coastal trail that connects Namhang-dong's Management Office with Taejeongdae Park through Jungni Port and Gamji Coastal Trail. The trail has no shortage of things to see, from village guardian posts to stone towers and small piers. The view of the sea to the right-hand side of the trail and the mosaic tiles are also worthy of one's attention.

### Songjeong Surfing School

Songjeong Beach's shallow depth and optimal tidal and wind conditions make it a great place for surfers at beginner and intermediate levels. It is the only place in Korea to see southern tides in summer, and northeastern tides in fall and winter. As Songjeong Beach was the focal point of the first generation of the Korean surfer culture, it also offers systematic instruction on the art of riding the waves. Learn everything about surfing at Songjeong Surfing School; the courses offered are divided into 1-day, 3-day, and 5-day courses.

### Hocheon Village

The name of the village comes from the fact that the village saw frequent tiger ("ho") appearances, owing to its location in a mountain. The Namil Bar in the village is famous for being the filming site of the K-dramas *Fight for My Way*. ### Dongnaeupseong Trail

Dongnaeupseong Walled Town was a system of fortifications that combined the strengths of a mountainous fortress and a walled town. It ranged from the mountain at the back of Chungnyeolsa Shrine, where Dongjae Command Post is located, to the mountain behind Dongnaeupseong Local Confucian School, where Seongjae Command Post is located. Today's Dongnaeupseong Walled Town has a trail connecting the three command posts. The trail reveals stories of Dongnae's past, as well as its pains.

### Jang Yeong-sil Science Garden

Located at the North Gate of Dongnaeupseong Walled Town, this science garden commemorates Jang Yeong-sil, a Dongnae-born scientist during the reign of King Sejong in the Joseon period. It is an outdoor exhibition showing 19 replica pieces of Joseon-era astronomical instruments, including those invented by Jang Yeong-sil. A festival dedicated to Jang Yeong-sil is held on summer nights, featuring opportunities to learn more about celestial bodies and their observation. The science garden is open from 09:00 to 18:00, and is closed every Monday.


